The following bills were discussed:


Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 366 short titled AMEND LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT LAW was discussed by Senator Barnes. Representative Hunt made a motion that a favorable report be given to the Committee Substitute for Senate Bill 366. Motion passed.

House Bill 313 - Proposed Committee Substitute #2 was discussed by Representative Pulley. Representative Pulley noted the changes needed in this committee substitute. Representative P. Hunt sent forward an amendment to House Bill 313. She withdrew her amendment. Representative Tison made a motion that the bill be held until Thursday. He withdrew his motion.



Representative Pulley made a motion that the Committee Substitute #2 with changes be adopted and given a favorable report and that the Committee Substitute #1 be given an unfavorable report. Motion passed.

Senate Bill 296 short titled IMPERSONATING EMERGENCY PERSONNEL was discussed. An amendment was sent forward. Representative Hunt made a motion that Senate Bill 296 be held until Thursday. Motion passed.
